

## Educational Opportunity Program Transfer Student Services Agreement Plan

Please carefully read the statements below describing the requirements and services offered by the program. This agreement will help you navigate services available to you as a transfer EOP student.

## **General Provisions**

- 1. I agree to maintain full-time enrollment (12 units) per semester in order to be eligible for my full time financial aid award. Due to budget constraints, transfer students are not eligible for EOP grants. Students participating the EO. Learning Communities may be allocated (in the first semester only) a small grant.
- 2. If my GPA should fall below a 2.00 or if I am placed on Academic Probation or Academic Disqualification, I agree to meet with my EOP counselor for advising, academic planning, and/or counseling twice a semester and to fulfill the terms of my reinstatement contract through the Partnerships for Success Program.
- 3. I agree to seek tutorial assistance in EOP, or major department, as prescribed by the program.
- **4.** I agree to declare my major by my Junior year in accordance with University policy.
- **5.** I agree to complete an exit interview with EOP if I should decide to withdraw from the University at any point in my educational progression.
- **6.** I agree to participate in retention services and utilize program resources as outlined by my EOP Counselor and meet with an Faculty Student Mentor Program Mentor once each semester.

## As a Transfer Student: Third Year and Beyond

- 7. I agree to participate in the EOP Learning Communities Program in the fall Semester. Placement in the learning community will be contingent upon my class level and will be optional.
- **8.** I agree to meet with my EOP counselor once a semester in the fall and the spring or as prescribed by my counselor.
- 9. I agree to participate in the junior and the Senior Success Program Component.
  - o Completion of my General Education Plan
  - o Career Workshops
  - o To attend a WPJ preparation workshop (if needed)
  - o Receive assistance in applying for graduation and graduate school
  - Attendance of student success workshops (resume writing, personal statements, cover letters, etc.)
